**General Rules**

1. Scales at end of track. All tractors must be weighed in before pulling.
2. No one allowed on track except for track officials and contestants.
3. Operators must remain seated during the pull and must have complete control of tractor at all times.
4. No passengers allowed on tractors when pulling.
5. All tractors must stop immediately upon signal from judge. The pull shall be over when the forward motion of the tractor stops.
6. Consumption of alcohol or drinking in the track area will be cause for disqualification.
7. All tractors must be in neutral or park while being hitched and unhitched.
8. The class in which a tractor pulls will be based on the weight of the tractor with the driver who must be at least 16 (sixteen) years of age.
9. Contest to be governed by judges with all decisions final. Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any tractor if it is not being operated in such a manner as would be considered unsafe.
10. Rules for the operation of the contest will be available on the day of the Pull.
11. Officials have the right to inspect tractors and serial numbers at random and upon request.
12. Violation of any rule or disagreement with directors shall constitute a disqualification.
13. Tractors pull in order of sign up.
14. All tractors must go directly to scale to be weighed after each pull is finished.

## **TRACTOR RULES**

1. Must have NO engine modifications. NO turbo chargers unless manufacturers option. Pumps must be original.
2. May run pressed steel wheels and may run narrow front ends only if that is an option with that model of tractor.
3. Three point hitches may NOT be removed.
4. Must use original manufacturer tractor draw bar.
5. Draw bar is to be stationary in all directions.
6. Maximum height of 20 (twenty) inches from top hitching devices parallel to ground.
7. Tractor drawbars will be allowed to build up to height. Must use cleaves or D ring for hook up.
8. All weights must be securely bolted to rear wheels only and must not extend beyond 6 (six) inches from outside of rims. Only 1 (one) set of weights allowed on front wheels.
9. Weight brackets and hand weights are allowed. If a weight or bracket falls off during a pull, that puller will be disqualified in that class.
10. All stock tractors must burn only stock fuel. Any fuel sampled and found to be other than stock will disqualify tractor and driver from competition.
11. Tires may be 1 (one) size oversized only.
12. No cut tires.
13. All tractors must be at original R.P.M.
14. All tractors must be in original condition.
15. **No weights are to be placed behind the rear wheels.**

## **OPERATION OF CONTEST**

1. Number one puller will be test puller and may take pull if weight of machine is ok, or he may pull in third position. If weight machine needs further adjustment, first puller after each adjustment will be treated as number one puller. All decisions on repulls must be made before tractor in question is unhooked from sled. On any repull caused by a contest malfunction, puller at this point (own discretion) may drop back three positions. Any disqualifications on first attempt, bars a second attempt.
2. If presiding judge is notified of a tractor with mechanical problems, he may drop contestant three positions. This may be done only once per contestant per class.
3. All pulls must start with a tight hitch. Contestants will be allowed two consecutive attempts and 50 (fifty) feet to start the sled.
4. Each tractor may compete in 3 (three) classes.
5. All contestants pull at own risk.
